# An excerpt from Flagstaff's Update on Fine Foods Precautionary Recall

Flagstaff Fine Foods would like to thank you and your clients for your patience and understanding during the recent Fine Foods Precautionary Recall. As a supplier, we care about the wellbeing of our clients' so we took an overly cautious approach.

We believe Flagstaff's duty of care to inform clients through a *precautionary recall* was the best approach in managing any risk to clients. Flagstaff took this decision very seriously and we worked with the NSW Food Authority to ensure there was no potential risk to any clients. No illnesses were reported.

Flagstaff has been transparent to our customers through this process, worked side by side with the NSW Food Authority during our testing phase, and followed the advice as provided by the NSW Food Authority to conduct a precautionary recall when low levels of listeria was detected in routine testing found in one particular component sourced externally.

This is the first recall in 22 years of Fine Foods operation.

Following on from further testing and research, the NSW Food Authority advised that the eight (8) recalled frozen meals are safe for consumption as long as the cooking instructions are followed.

On the Fine Foods packaging you may see the addition of a new green label. This green label will clearly state the cooking instructions to ensure all meals are cooked appropriately. Flagstaff will continue to conduct independent testing of our meals and work with the NSW Food Authority to ensure that cooking instructions are clearly visible.

As a not for profit disability enterprise, supporting people with a disability through employment and life skills programs, we understand and value the support Meals on Wheels provides.

Your clients, volunteers and committee are welcome to visit our facility to see how we operate to relieve any concerns you may have. We will be holding an Open Day on Friday, 8 November 2019 at our site at 254 Nolan Street Unanderra from 10 am to 12 noon and would love you to join us.
